The use of two gallery spaces is essential to allow visitors to explore Keith Haring's interest in primal arts and ancient cultures, while reflecting the contemporary concerns of an artist influenced by the impact of technology and the challenges ahead.

Haring creates a dynamic tension between tradition and modernity through an iconography that merges ancestral motifs, postmodern visions, and elements of science fiction, all imbued with reflections on humanity's future.

The exhibition features a selection of more than 70 artworks, including masks, sculptures, paintings, objects, and terracotta pieces, illustrating the unique dialogue that the artist establishes between ritual and the technological world.
